**DIVERSION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
CHURCH STREET, WHITTINGTON**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Staffordshire County Council on 6 July 2021 made an Order the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in that length of Church Street in Whittington from its junction with Main Street, Common Lane and Fisherwick Road to outside property number 2 unless the vehicle is being used in connection with the works or is being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes. Access for pedestrians and cyclists will be available.

An alternative route for traffic is available via Main Street, Back Lane, Church Street and vice versa. For more information, visit: <https://one.network/?tm=122118669>.

The order will come into operation from 08:00 hours on 11 July 2021 and the said works will commence on or as near as practicable to that date. It is anticipated that the works will be completed by 17:30 hours on the same day.

The Order will remain in force for a period of 18 months, or until the rectification works of 4 sunken and polished covers undertaken by Cadent, which it is proposed to carry out on or near the road have been completed, whichever is the earlier.
